Career Highlights

Prior to founding his own firm, McMillan Analysis Corporation in 1991, Larry was a proprietary trader at two major brokerage firms. He began his Wall Street career as the retail option strategist at Thomson McKinnon Securities, Inc., from 1976 to 1980, and then traded the firm's proprietary account beginning in 1980. From 1982 to 1989, he was a Senior Vice President in charge of the Equity Arbitrage Department before moving to Prudential-Bache Securities where he led the Proprietary Option Trading Department from 1989 to 1990.

National Recognition

Larry has been recognized as one of the industry's top strategists and for his newsletters and books covering equity, index, and futures options with emphasis on strategy, not speculation. "The Option Strategist Newsletter" received the National Association of Active Investment Managers (NAAIM) 2010 President's Award for Excellence in Financial Newsletter Writing; Larry was the recipient of the prestigious Options Industry Council Sullivan Award in 2011 for his outstanding contributions to the growth and integrity of the U.S. options market; and he was inducted into the Trading Hall of Fame in 2001 for his accomplishments as an exceptional trader and educator and who has helped grow the industry through his dedication and commitment.

Larry, and his wife, Janet, currently make their home in Randolph, NJ, and have two children, Karen, who works with Larry, and Glen, a proprietary trader in Chicago, and six grandchildren.
