## Burrell '81 Recognized For NFF Leadership

After 11 years as President of the Joe Tiller Chapter of the National Football Foundation, Bart Burrell is passing the gavel to his successor.

Jim Vrugink, Executive Director noted, "Bart has provided great leadership, direction and community support for the chapter in guiding it from its infancy in 2004 to become one of the largest chapters among the 120 nationwide, helping Purdue accomplish its goals of getting more former players into the College Football and Indiana Football Halls of Fame and providing scholarships totaling almost \$250,000 for more than 200 scholar-athletes as they transition from high school to college."

Bart was particularly happy to have helped in getting his long time friend and Purdue football teammate Mark Herrmann inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame.
