Addressing Changing Learning Methods

Through the Hall brother's generosity the Presentation study room was revamped to better accommodate the changing learning methods being used in different courses at Purdue. With the online tools available today many classes are incorporating more small group assignments that require getting together and accessing and displaying information on homework assignments and class projects.

Presentation Room Upgrades

The upgrades to this room provide a comfortable setting for small group sessions and the ability to share and display information while together. The room now has a longer table that can seat 8 to 10, a central video monitor where information on laptops can be displayed, a separate study alcove, and a new all-in-one printer/scanner/copier.

Nate Graber '18 who worked with Butch Brose to redo this room remarked, "The brothers are really thankful and grateful for the generosity of Robert and Tom Hall. The opportunity to have a place in the chapter house that lets us do small group projects and study together has been a real plus. We really appreciate the new study space and updated equipment."

A Big Thank You


