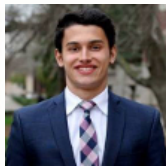

At the Annual Purdue Greek Awards, Delta Delta brothers received the top Fraternity awards.



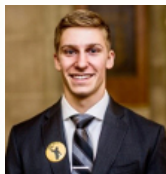
Chapter Recognition Awards for 2016-2017
