The Sigs in Indiana got together for the 133rd Indiana State Day event held on Saturday, February 18 in Indianapolis. Brothers from all nine Indiana Sigma Chi chapters took part making this one of Sigma Chi's largest events with almost 500 alumni and undergraduates in attendance.

The chapter raised \$29,935 for various philanthropic organizations and our brothers donated 2,019 hours of their time to community service.
